- A monthly Omnibus is conducted across WA using WA's largest online panel comprising more than 50,000 active members.
- The data is collected across the last week of each month.
- A total of n=1,600 responses were received for the April 2012 Omnibus.
- The data is post-weighted to ABS Census statistics for Age, Gender and Metro/Regional population.
- The McCusker Centre for Action on Alcohol and Youth placed three questions onto the April 2012 Omnibus.

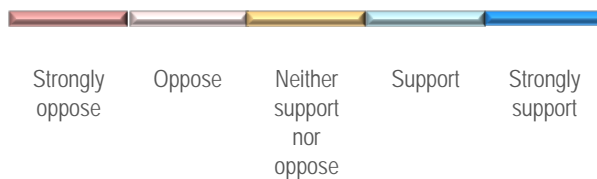


"To what extent, if at all, do you support or oppose all school students having regular, well-resourced alcohol and drug education?"

(n=425)



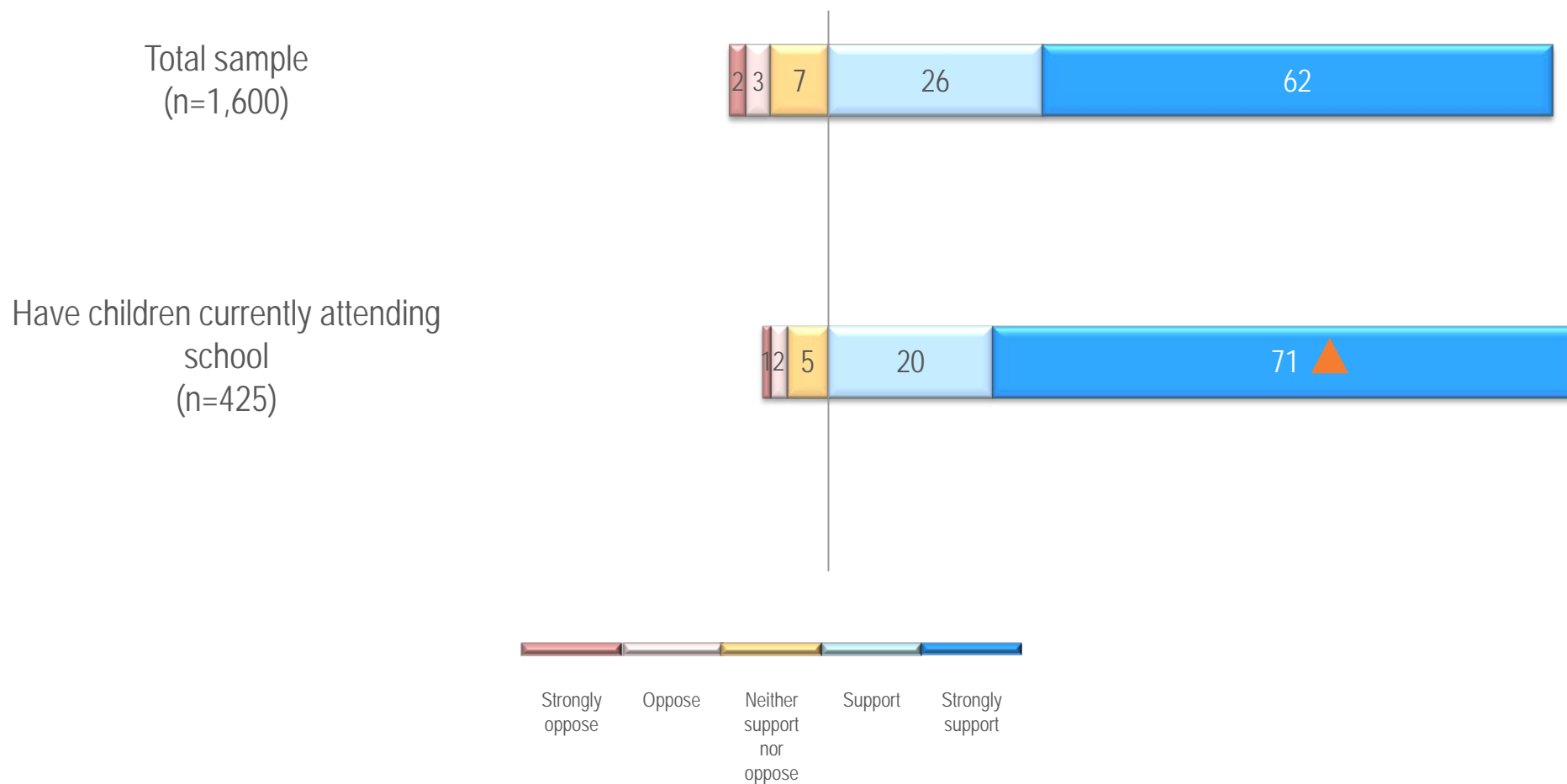

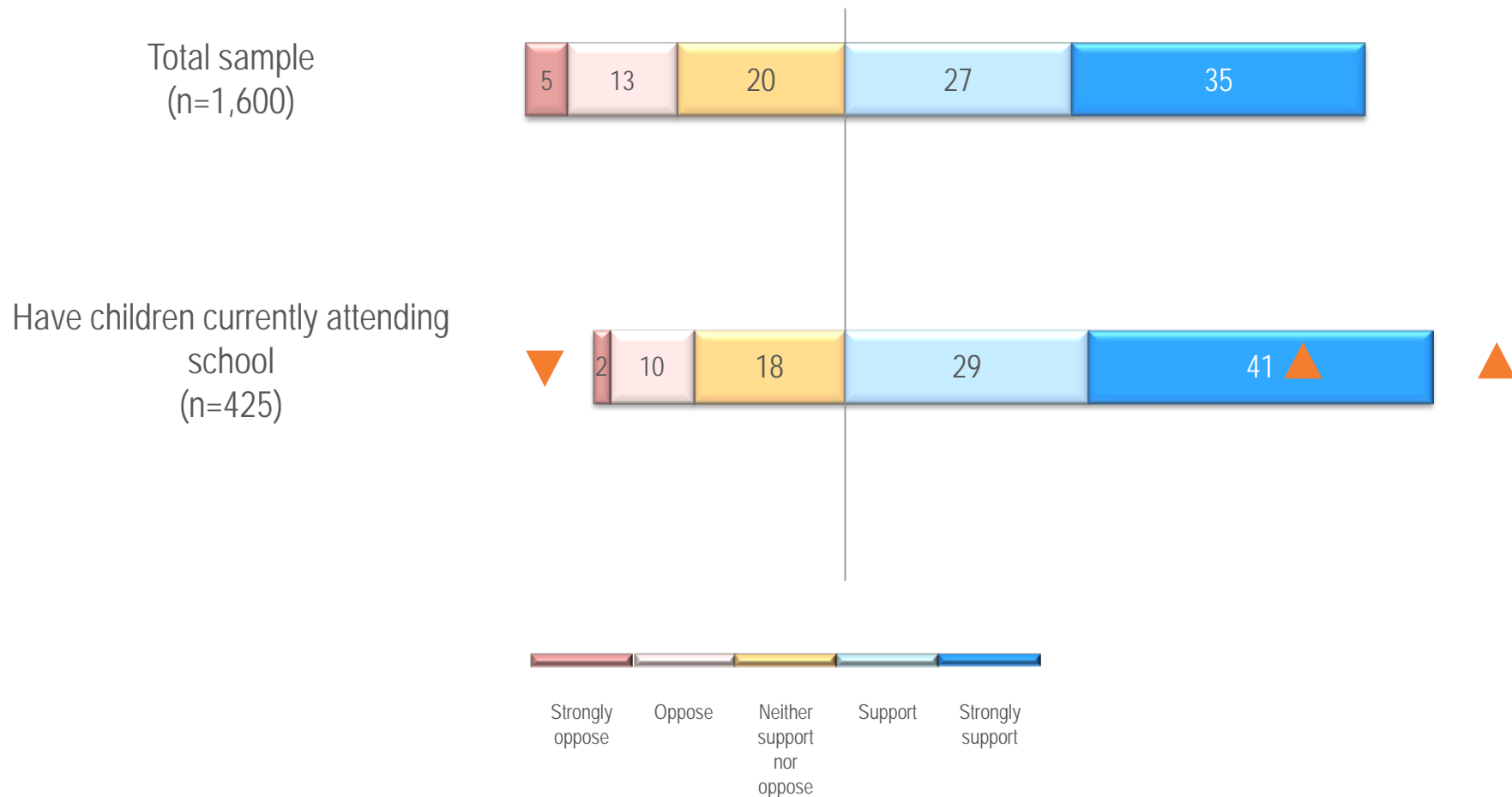
